An Australian Directors' Guild award nominee for her directing of drama serial *The Heights* for Matchbox Pictures and NBC Universal, Renée was also the Set-Up Director for the children's TV drama *Itch*.

Renée's commercial campaign direction won Silver in London at the FAB World Awards for her Brownes Campaign, Silver and Bronze Directing PADC Awards and Best In Show at Oasis Campaign Brief and PADC Awards.

Renée's short films Scoff and Edgar and Elizabeth secured awards and festival screenings worldwide, including Berlin Asia Pacific Film Fest (Berlin); LA Short Shorts Film Festival; Hamptons Film Festival; High Falls (New York); Female Eye Toronto Film Festival and All Time Best Shorts; London Australian Film Festival; St Kilda Film Festival and Flickerfest International Film Festival.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

How to Please a Woman is a naughty film. It concerns itself with women's desire, sensuality and sexuality. It despairs about the housework. And it has a fixation with what it feels like to swim in the ocean first thing in the morning.


One of our themes is female sexual empowerment. We honour what women look like and give sexual stories to women 'no longer young, and not yet old'.

This is a film made with lots of heart. We were gifted with actors who brought humanity and complexity. The cast were fearless and open in getting the tone right, and it's this commitment that underpins the tone of the drama within the comedy.

I want this film to come roaring out of the left field and mainline it for your heart, to be a comedy that is filled with surprise and power and relatability.

THE DIRECTORS

Both directors and screenwriters, Marco and Antonio Manetti made their directorial debut in 1995 with an episode in the film *De Generazione*. Their film *Zora la Vampira* was released in 2000, followed by *Piano 17*, *Paura 3D* and *L'Arrivo di Wang*. In 2013, they received unanimous consent from critics and public with *Song 'e Napule*.

In 2017 their film *Ammore e Malavita* was presented at Venice Film Festival. The film won many awards such as the David di Donatello Award for Best Picture. Their new film *Diabolik*, an adaptation of the comic book by Angela and Luciana Giussani, will be released in December 2021. Among others, the Manetti Bros. also directed the cult television series *L'Ispettore Coliandro*. The duo has also produced and shot web-series as well as music videos for some of the most emblematic names in Italian music.



DIRECTORS' NOTE

We don't like the word "dream" because it makes you think of an unexpected lucky break rather than something obtained through planning and work. Nonetheless, directing *Diabolik* is the closest thing to realizing a dream that we have ever done. A dream fulfilled thanks to our work and our perseverance through the years. We have tried to bring to the screen the exciting noir stories written by the Giussani sisters and Mario Gomboli and to rebuild Clerville's dark atmospheres. We made an attempt to give a face, thanks to an extraordinary cast, to the protagonists created by the great authors of the comic book, like Enzo Facciolo and Sergio Zaniboni, and to replicate the minimalist elegance of this comic book, through the scenery, the costumes, and the lights which are strongly inspired by the comic. And finally, add to that the challenge of setting everything "towards the end of the 60's".


DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Some years ago I started reflecting on aging, maybe my own, and how sadly older women often are portrayed on film. I wanted to tell a story about the passion, desire and fire that still burns just as strong even when the body ages. I love movies with food. I love to eat, cook and watch food being cooked. It is sensual and beautiful and a pretty good metaphor for life and different personalities. When cooking what looks easy for some fails for others despite safe recipes.

My ambition was to make a warm and entertaining film about all the invisible "ordinary" women, about their friendship, love and passion. About daring to take the step and dream a little bigger even when you don't have a whole life ahead of you. I wanted to make a film one can recognize oneself in, a film that tickles the imagination makes you laugh and cry at the same time. After the movie, I hope no one wants to go home, but embrace life and continue into the night with a smile on their face, inhale the life that is left, love a little bit more and eat good food!




His films have won numerous national and international awards, including the Oscar and the Student Oscar, as well as numerous German and Bavarian Film Awards.

THE STORY

The Odd-Job Men tells the story of a week in the life of Moha, Valero and Pep – workers in a small plumbing and electricity company in the outskirts of Barcelona: they are the guys who enter your home and fix what's broken. Moha, the youngest, is on a one-week trial period with the company. He is shy but does surprisingly well with customers. Moha is set to replace Pep, who is about to retire. However, Valero is not at all comfortable with Pep retiring. He doubts Moha has what it takes, or that customers will accept a Moroccan worker. Maybe six days are not enough to make somebody change, to make him overcome his prejudices. Maybe it's not enough time to make a new friend. But it's possibly enough to discover that we have to live together: one small step for a plumber, but a giant leap for mankind.

THE DIRECTOR

Neus Ballús is a director for cinema and documentary based in Barcelona. Her first feature-length film *The Plague* (2013) was screened at the 63rd Berlinale and received more than 20 awards at festivals around the world. The film won four Gaudí Awards in 2013: Best Movie, Best Director, Best Film Editing and Best Screenplay and Ballús was also nominated for the Goya Award for Best New Director. Her last film, *Staff Only* (2019) premiered at Berlinale and was screened at many European festivals. *The Odd-Job Men* won Best Actor and the Europa Cinemas Label Award at Locarno 2021 and so far went on to play at TIFF, Busan and BFI London.



THE STORY

Stefan Ruzowitzky was born in 1961 in Vienna, Austria. Raised in Düsseldorf, Germany, he studied theatre, media, film and history. Ruzowitzky is best known for his Oscar-winning 2008 feature film *The Counterfeiters*. In 1998 *The Inheritors* became a festival hit at festivals like Telluride, New York Film Festival and Toronto, winning more than 20 international awards. *Anatomy* (2000) became the top grossing German genre movie ever. Stefan has worked in the US, directing *Deadfall* (2012) and co-creating internationally successful series like *8 Days* and *The Barbarians*.





THE STORY

Alfred Garnes is a working-class sailor, who has recently become the father of a third child. He and his childhood friend Sigbjørn Kvalen (Wally) are working on a merchant ship in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean when World War II breaks out. They are unarmed civilians on the front lines of a war they never asked to join. The two men struggle for survival in a spiral of violence and death, where at any moment German submarines may attack their valuable vessels. The war sailors have one goal: to survive – and to return home. Meanwhile, Alfred's wife Cecilia struggles through the war alone in Bergen, raising three children on her own, not knowing whether she will ever see Alfred again. When British aircrafts attempt to bomb the German submarine bunker in Bergen, they instead hit the primary school at Laksevåg and civilian homes at Nøstet, resulting in hundreds of civilian deaths. When the news reaches Alfred and Wally in Canada, they wonder if they have anything left at home to return to.
